## **NEW BUSINESS:**

Discussion/Action: Discussion/Review of HB 4 Civil Rights Act - Qualified Immunity as it relates to Police Officers - Chief Keven Summers.

The governing body was provided with a copy of the following: Final Legislative Report showing the HB4 signed by the Governor, Senate Bill 8 54th Legislature, State of New Mexico, First special Session 2020, introduced by Joseph Cervantes as relating to Law Enforcement, House Bill 4, 55th Legislature, State of New Mexico, First Session 2021, Introduced by Georgene Louis and Brian Egolf and Joseph Cervantes. Also provided was a summary of Chief Summers' notes discussing the New Mexico Civil Rights Act and Body Cam Law.

The governing body and Chief Summers discussed prior history and how we had gotten to this point in time. Open discussion ensued for two hours regarding where policing is going and changes that will need to be made in policy. Lawsuits that could potentially affect the Municipality even with changes being put into place in policy format. Major areas of concern that policy will be changed in are Foot Pursuit, Private Property & Use of Force.

Topics of discussion regarding the above as well as Code Enforcement, Civil Standbys, Alarm Responses and Body Cam Redaction were pursued. (Item #5)
