

Village Code 7-1A-9 (c)**


The Village Council Board of Trustees in Regular Session on May 10, 2022, declared that Level One Water Restrictions are hereby implemented. Under Level One Water Restrictions:

- (1) Level One Water Emergency shall apply to all individuals and properties served by the Village of Cloudcroft water system, including those properties outside the village limits.
- (2) No entity or operation served by the village water system shall waste, cause, or permit to be wasted or applied to non-beneficial uses any water furnished by the Village of Cloudcroft.
- (3) No entity or operation shall cause or permit the flow of excess water onto adjacent property or public right-of-way.
- (4) Outdoor watering (spray irrigation) is allowed from six o'clock (6:00) p.m. to ten (10:00) a.m.
- (5) Personal vehicles may be washed only during the watering hours listed above and only with a bucket or with a handheld hose with an attached positive shut off nozzle.
